FINAL CLASSIFICATION AND VALUE REPORT (RFCV)

DEFINITION	<p>Value and classification control involves determining the customs treatment to be given to imported goods. This control consists of determining the customs value of imported goods and assigning a tariff heading to these goods in accordance with the HS nomenclature (Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System), for the purposes of collecting duties and taxes. This control is carried out by Customs.</p> <p>All goods whose FOB value is greater than or equal to one (1) million FCFA must obtain a Final Classification and Value Report (RCCV) via the electronic platform of the GUCE – Cf. Customs circular n°1618 of June 21, 2013.</p> <p>Imports with an FOB value less than or equal to one (1) million FCFA and certain other products (see list of goods not subject to the RFCV on the website www.douane.ci) are exempt from the RFCV procedure. These goods must however obtain a Verification Certificate (AV) issued by the Directorate of Risk Analysis, Intelligence and Value (DARRV) of the Ivorian Customs</p>
DESCRIPTION DE LA PROCEDURE	<p>As soon as the goods are loaded and all the transport documents for the goods are available, the importer or the forwarding agent appointed :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Connect to the Value Certificate Request module of the GUCE platform.2. Enter information in the fields of the form.3. Download and fill.4. He attaches the documents accompanying the goods : the Deposit Notice (AD), the commercial invoice, the FDI if necessary, the transport document, the packing list, the insurance certificate, the freight invoice, etc..5. He submits the request which will be processed by Customs. <p>N.B.: Access to the site requires prior registration as an importer or freight forwarder</p>
