

## **DOCUMENT**

## **API - INTENTION TO IMPORT RECORDED MEDIA**

DEFINITION	Any natural or legal person is free to import Recorded Media (Phonograms and Videograms) subject to obtaining a Prior Import Authorization in accordance with Interministerial Order No. 13 of February 7, 1984 issued by BURIDA (Ivorian Office of the Copyright).

## The procedure described is manual

The importer goes to BURIDA at the Direction de la Reproduction Mécanique & Stickers (DRM & Stickers) to buy a printout "Intention d'Importation ».

This Import Intention is subscribed in tranches of

**1.1 copies**, regardless the number of titles of CDs albums, DVDs or printed works.

The importer completes the Import Intention Form and submits this Form to DRM & Stickers with the following documents:

- The applicant's identity document.
- The Invoice of the goods.
- Possibly, all documents concerning the distribution of these supports (Producer contract, Distribution licence, etc.)
- Possibly, a Receipt of payment of the mechanical reproduction rights (paid abroad).

The Import Intention is signed by the **Director General of BURIDA**.

The Intention to Import is then transmitted to the DRM and Stickers which dispatches an agent1 from the Service responsible for the Fight against Piracy.

The latter goes with the Importer to the Port of entry into the territory to carry out the usual checks (Distribution license, Compliance of the declaration ...).

If the controlled objects are in conformity, the agent of the service in charge of the Fight against Piracy affixes the **visa of BURIDA** on **the Intention to import**.

The importer can then proceed with the passage of his **Customs declaration**.

COST	<ul> <li>This Intention to Import is subscribed to in tranches of 1,000 copies, irrespective of the number of titles of CD albums, DVDs or printed works.</li> <li>Cost: 10,000 FCFA per 1,000 copies.</li> <li>In the event that proof of payment abroad of the mechanical reproduction rights cannot be provided, the importer must pay these rights to BURIDA.</li> <li>The cost of the mechanical reproduction rights then amounts to: <ul> <li>For phonogram carriers:</li> <li>160 FCFA per unit if the selling price of the support is less than or equal to Three thousand (3000) FCFA.</li> <li>250 FCFA per unit when the selling price of the support is higher than Three thousand (3000) FCFA.</li> </ul> </li> <li>For videogram supports: 8% of the selling price of the support.</li> </ul>
DELIVERY DELAY	Within 24 hours.
