EXPORT INSECT CONTROL CERTIFICATE FOR COCOA COFFEE

DEFINITION	<p>In the cocoa export procedure, product quality control is followed by phytosanitary treatment before shipment..</p> <p>Fumigation is carried out by one of the private companies approved by the Ministry of Agriculture, which issues a Treatment Certificate or a Certificate of Insect Control (AD).</p> <p>The list of approved operators for the 2017-2018 campaign can be consulted on the Conseil Café Cacao website. The procedures for obtaining approval are described on the following website: http://servicepublic.gouv.ci/accueil/demarcheparticulier/2/100/13</p> <p>The <u>phytosanitary treatment certificate</u> is valid for TWENTY days from the date of treatment. After this period, any batches not exported must be reprocessed..</p> <p>During the period of validity of the phytosanitary treatment certificate, the authorities will issue, free of charge, a docking authorisation and then, after shipment, a phytosanitary certificate (art. 17 of Decree 2012.1011).</p>
PROCEDURE DESCRIPTION	Importers should contact one of the companies approved by the Cocoa Coffee Council and agree a date for fumigation..
STATE STRUCTURE(S) CONCERNED	Cocoa Coffee Council
COST	Tariffs are negotiated between the exporter and companies approved by the Cocoa Coffee Council..
DELIVERY TIME	The day following fumigation.
APPLICATION DOCUMENTS REQUIRED	List of batches to be fumigated.
LEGAL BASIS (LEGAL REFERENCE)	Interministerial Order 0008/MBPE/MEF/MINADER of 31 March 2017.
