## **AUTHORISATION TO DOCK FOR THE EXPORT OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS**

DEFINITION	The phytosanitary inspection results in the issue of an <b>Authorisation for Release to Quay (AMQ).</b> The AMQ certifies that the goods have been inspected from a phytosanitary point of view, possibly fumigated (if required by law) and that they are free from pests and suitable for shipment. The weights of each batch are listed in the QMA. The loading authorisation is the document that authorises the freight forwarder to proceed with the loading of the announced and inspected consignments.
PROCEDURE DESCRIPTION	Submit the request for phytosanitary inspection to the sub- directorate for phytosanitary inspection at borders (port, airport, land border, etc.).
Phytosanitary inspection at the seaport or airport.	
STATE STRUCTURE(S) CONCERNED	Ministry of agriculture Directorate General for Production Directorate for Plant Protection and Quality Control Sub-Directorate of Phytosanitary Inspection
COSTS	See the costs of the phytosanitary inspection
DELIVERY TIME	Within 24 hours of physical inspection of the goods.
