

DOCUMENT IMPORT DECLARATION FORM (IDF)

DEFINITION	All imports of goods or merchandise with an FOB value of 500,000 FCFA or more require an Import Declaration Form (FDI). This document is issued electronically on the GUCE platform by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade. The FDI is the only document required for Customs declarations and for the arrival inspection procedure, whether the products are imported freely or under the approval system.
PROCEDURE DESCRIPTION	The FDI is issued electronically on the GUCE platform. It is subject to the prior creation of a Virtual Trade Transaction File (VTF) on the same platform (https://www.guce.gouv.ci). The VTF is created by the approved Importer or Customs Broker and provides the information required to create the FDI, in particular the nature and customs nomenclature of the goods, the mode of transport, the type of load, the direct debit bank and the Importer Code. The FDI is then issued electronically after downloading a Pro-forma invoice domiciled at the user's bank (this operation is also carried out in the GUCE). The FDI is personal and non-transferable; it is valid for a period of three (3) months from the date of approval by the DirectionGénérale du Commerce Extérieur and may be extended for three (3) non-renewable months. N.B.: To access the site, you must first be
	registered as an importer or forwarding agent (https://guce.gouv.ci/register/procedure).
