

DOCUMENT PHYTOSANITARY CONTROL CERTIFICATE FOR IMPORTS

	The Phytosanitary Import Control Certificate verifies that the product complies with the regulations in force in Côte d'Ivoire.
DEFINITION	It is issued by the Phytosanitary Inspection Services at the Port of Abidjan (located at the Guichet Unique du Port, Boulevard du Port, Abidjan), at the Port of San-Pedro (located at the Guichet Unique Café - Cacao, San-Pedro), at the Airport and at land borders.
	These services come under the Plant Protection, Control and Quality Department of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development.
	The phytogenitary application must be submitted to the phytogenitary increation
PROCEDURE DESCRIPTION	 The phytosanitary application must be submitted to the phytosanitary inspection services (ports, airports, borders) of the Department of Plant Protection, Control and Quality of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, together with the following file: Copy of the Customs Declaration. Request for Phytosanitary Control submitted by the Importer or his forwarding agent. Transport document. The Phytosanitary Certificate of the country of origin of the plant or plant product. Results of analysis for products (in the case of laboratory analysis). The inspection service inspects the goods and issues the Phytosanitary Control Certificate.
